She loves clinical work but has also taught graduate-level psychology at Michigan State University and has worked as a neurodevelopmental consultant/evaluator at St. Joseph Hospital for over 10 years. She is a nationally known expert and speaker on the identification and treatment of Selective Mutism, a childhood anxiety disorder, and loves working with families to promote "brave talking". Dr. Kotrba has authored Selective Mutism: An Assessment and Intervention Guide for Therapists, Educators, and Parents and Overcoming Selective Mutism: A Field Guide for Parents. She created and co-directs Confident Kids Camp, a camp for children and teens with Selective Mutism that runs annually in Brighton Michigan (with offshoot camps in the metro DC area and Toronto, Canada). 1 Radisson Plaza, New Rochelle, NY 10801 <u>From Points North</u> – I-95 South to Exit 16 New Rochelle. *Bear left onto Cross Westchester Ave. Stay in left lane. Continue straight under railroad bridge onto Cedar St. Turn left onto Radisson Plaza (Toyota Dealer on left). Turn right into Hotel NoMa entrance.
